Compared to previous years, Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas dispensed a record amount of donor milk in 2014, almost half a million ounces. 441,295 ounces is a lot of milk! It is so heartwarming and satisfying that we are continually able to help more and more premature and critically ill infants. This wouldn't be possible without the commitment and dedication of our donor mothers, board of directors, milk bank staff and volunteers.

2014 was also significant because we reached the milestone of dispensing donor milk for 10 years. The 10 Year Anniversary Luncheon in September was a special day of recollection and appreciation. We took a trip down memory lane, heard very special milk donor and recipient stories, and celebrated with friends, supporters and colleagues.

#### 8 New Milk Collection Depots Added in 2014

Collecting donor milk for pasteurization at Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas is accomplished in many ways, most commonly through collection sites otherwise known as milk depots. Depots make it easy and convenient for donors to drop off breastmilk. They are equipped with freezers for safe monitoring and storage. Of our 38 current depots, eight were added in 2014 and two, so far, in 2015:

- In 2014, MMBNT was one of the largest producing non-profit milk banks in the United States.
- We are located in Fort Worth's Medical District on Magnolia Avenue by the Paris Coffee Shop.
- Milk is dispensed by physician prescription for premature and critically ill babies.
- We pasteurize donor milk and test it for bacteria before packaging.
- Babies prescribed donor milk are never turned away based on their ability to pay processing fees.

Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas partnered with the Tarrant County Breastfeeding Coalition for the first Latch On Texas event last August at the Fort Worth Botanic Garden. With hundreds in attendance celebrating World Breastfeeding Month, 277 moms breastfed their babies simultaneously at 10 a.m. This was the largest event of its kind in the state of Texas. Families also visited vendor tables, participated in a silent auction and enjoyed the photo booth.

# MMBNT Holds Guinness World Record™ for Most Breastmilk Donated

Six donors to Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas are among recent and current Guinness World Record ™ holders for "Most Breastmilk Donated". Since Granbury resident Alicia Richman set a record in 2012 with 11,115 ounces, five additional area women were inspired to pump, store and donate their extra breastmilk to Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas.

On August 4, 2014, Alyse Ogletree of Argyle, Texas was awarded the Guinness World Record ™ title for Most Breastmilk Donated. Ogletree donated 53,081 ounces (or 414 gallons) of her own breastmilk to Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas between January 2011 and March 2014.

Fort Worth mother Brittani Goodson previously held the title from July 16, 2014 to July 25, 2014. Goodson, a mother of two, donated 33,410 ounces between November 2012 and January 2014. She was named the record holder only two weeks after Guinness World Records crowned another Fort Worth mother, Katy Edgington, for donating 23,251 ounces. In March 2013, Sara Pascale from Fairview, Texas held the world record for 11,200 ounces followed by Karen Merheb from Dallas for 14,243 ounces.

## Chetna Patel - A Donor Mom Tells Her Story

I was blessed with a baby boy last year, Riyan. I always wanted to keep him exclusively on breastmilk, so I had started pumping and storing extra milk after 2 weeks. I was producing a lot of milk and was able to store around 1,000 ounces in 3 months.

Unfortunately, my little one was diagnosed with cardiomyopathy when he was 3 months old and ended up in the cardiac NICU for a month. But he didn't make it. I can't forget those days in the hospital; it was so heartbreaking seeing infants in such bad conditions.

I decided to donate my milk that was meant for my Riyan, so that it

could still be used to bless the lives of little babies who need it. I found out about Mothers' Milk Bank of North Texas. They made the donation process so easy and I was able to donate milk. MMBNT is doing amazing work.
