Complete a 30 minute interview & medical history questionnaire

**call 817-810-0071 to screen in advance (not required)*

Free, 5 minute, non-fasting blood test with an onsite phlebotomist

Donate your extra frozen breastmilk!

**Donors must be approved before milk can be processed and sent to fragile babies. Until then, we can safely store your milk. Please note that, for safety reasons, milk cannot be returned. You can also schedule a milk pick-up after completing steps 1 & 2 at the milk drive.*
